1. Meeting began at 2:15pm with Pledge of Allegiance
2. Bob made motion to accept Warrant #27, Ilene 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor
3. Bob made motion to enter Public Hearing for new guidelines General Assistance. Ilene 2<sup>nd</sup>. All in favor.
4. Bob made motion to exit public hearing and to accept the Maine General Assistance Guidelines. Pam 2<sup>nd</sup> . All in favor.
5. Discussion on state mandate regarding COVID 19 pay (more research needed) per Mary only applies when over 10 people?
6. Pam will follow-up with Melinda on EMD paperwork. Needs to be voted on at town meeting. Per Melinda still needs Flood zone info. Needs to be a PUBLIC meeting prior to being put in the warrant. Time line discussed.
7. Mary purchased answering machine, but has not had time to set it up.
8. Need Boston Cane from Cullivan's to present to new holder at the Town Meeting (assuming that there is one)
9. Discussion regarding town reports , printer deadlines, etc.
10. Bob asked again for itemized budget from everyone in preparation for budget meetings in January . Bob will create Zoom meeting & invite those who are able .
11. Fire Department looking for lease agreement for garage on the Banton Road. They want to enlarge for new fire truck storage. They responded to large fire at Haskell's, but truck "died" & they will need assistance (money)
12. Discussion regarding going all on line like some other towns. It was agreed the curbside service was not a good option with current staff & weather. Will keep open as it is now, with only two public allowed in at a time. All staff need to adhere to Covid 19 mandates including wiping public area down frequently. COVERING mouth when you cough or sneeze etc.
